



## **IJUSEng Open Access**

### **Information for Authors**

#### **Introduction**

IJUSEng is committed to offer authors different options when publishing their research. IJUSEng allows Open Access Archiving (i.e., posting the accepted manuscript in an Institutional Repository or on a personal webpage). Authors can also choose to publish Open Access and therefore make their articles freely available for non-commercial use.

#### **Open Access Mandates**

A number of funding agencies and institutions now mandate Open Access publication of work that they support. IJUSEng is fully compliant with the requirements of NIH, The Wellcome Trust, UKRC, HHMI, and similar agencies.

## **New requirements**

- From 7 April 2008, the NIH will require that all peer-reviewed articles, wholly or partially deriving from NIH funds, must be submitted to PubMedCentral (PMC) upon acceptance for publication.
- Authors must ensure that the copyright transfer agreements that they sign with a journal publisher must allow them to make the manuscript held in the PMC archive freely available within 12 months of publication of the article.

## **How to comply with IJUSEng**

- The IJUSEng's standard transfer of copyright agreement allows authors to place a copy of their accepted manuscript in a variety of places, including PMC.
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- IJUSEng is listed as a 'Green' publisher in the SHERPA/RoMEO database of publishers' copyright and self-archiving policies.
- IJUSEng offers authors the ability to publish their articles under an Open Access model.

Full details of Open Access Archiving policies are as follows.

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IJUSEng's policies are fully compliant with the requirements of NIH, The Wellcome Trust, UKRC, HHMI and similar agencies. Thus, IJUSEng is listed as a 'Green' publisher in the SHERPA/RoMEO database of publishers' copyright policies and self-archiving ([www.sherpa.ac.uk/romeo](http://www.sherpa.ac.uk/romeo)).
