Full Statement of Author Guidelines

Article types

Original Article: Describes original research, or some aspect of design and operation, or engineering education.

Review Article: A critical review of the state-of-the-art of engineering developments or applications.

Case Study: Describes the application of a technique, procedure or operational concept in a real situation.

Technical Note: A short, interim statement on a research project or description of a new development.

Other types: Point-of-view articles, correspondence, conference reports.

Manuscript length

Original articles, review papers and case studies should not normally exceed 5000 words and 10 illustrations. Longer articles will be considered on the criterion that the content justifies the length of the manuscript. Technical notes should not exceed 1500 words and 5 illustrations. Discussions on papers already published should not exceed 500 words and 2 illustrations.

Peer review policy

Submissions to IJUSEng are assessed by independent referees who make recommendations on the suitability of the manuscripts for publication. Our refereeing process is double-blind. We are committed to providing timely assessment of articles and authors are informed of the publication decision as soon as possible.

Expected academic and professional protocols

Marques Aviation Ltd Press cannot accept an article if it is not the author's original work, has been published before (except for an abstract of the work at a conference or publications in another language), or is currently under consideration for publication elsewhere. The article must not contain any libellous or unlawful statements or in any way infringe the rights of others. All authors must declare that they have read and agreed to the content of the submitted article. The author must be the owner of the copyright and be entitled to sign the Copyright Transfer Agreement. In submitting an article, the author complies with these conditions. In addition, the publisher reserves the right to re-referee and/or reject an accepted paper if the paper does not meet the criteria outlined in the review form or if the paper is in some other way deemed unsuitable. If the Author wishes to abandon the review process or remove his/her article from elsewhere in the system before publication, the article must be formally withdrawn in writing before it can be submitted to another journal. Previous publication in another language should be disclosed. The submission cannot have been previously published in English elsewhere. Such statements, along with explanations for exceptions to the above

rules, should be included in the *Comments to the Editor* section (for online submission), or in the covering letter (for email submission).

Copyright transfer agreement

Before publication Marques Aviation Ltd Press requires the author as the rights holder to sign a Copyright Transfer Agreement. This is a transfer of copyright, whereby Marques Aviation Ltd Press holds copyright in the work.

Conflicting interests

The author will be required to make a certification with respect to a declaration of conflicting interests.

Permissions

Authors are responsible for obtaining permission from copyright holders for reproducing illustrations, tables, figures or lengthy quotations previously published elsewhere. Authors that do not retain copyright of a previously published article require permission prior to using their own work. Papers will not be accepted for publication without the correct permissions.

Manuscript Style

Manuscript preparation

The text should be double-spaced throughout and with a minimum of 3 cm for left and right hand margins and 3 cm at head and foot. Text should be standard 12 point.

File types

All files, including Tables and Figures, should be submitted as a Word document.

Abstract and keywords

The title, keywords and abstract are key to ensuring readers find your article online through online search engines.

Notation

A notation may be included to define the main symbols used in the manuscript.

Corresponding author contact details

Provide full contact details for the corresponding author including email, mailing address and telephone numbers. Academic affiliations are required for all co-authors.

Guidelines for submitting artwork, figures and other graphics

Colour illustrations, pictures and graphs submitted in electronic format together with your accepted article will appear in colour online.

Mathematical typeface

All vectors and matrices should be shown in bold type. Avoid confusion between ambiguous characters and take care to ensure that subscripts and superscripts are clear. Numbers below 10 should be written out in the text unless used in conjunction with units (e.g., four coordinates, 4 m). Full points (not commas) should be used for

decimals. For numbers less than one, a nought should be inserted before the decimal point. Equations should be numbered sequentially throughout the document, with labels on the right hand side of the page.

Acknowledgements and conflicting interests

Contributors who do not meet the criteria for authorship should be listed in an *Acknowledgements* section. Acknowledgements and a Declaration of Conflicting Interests, if applicable, should appear at the end of your manuscript prior to the References.

Acknowledgement of funding

To comply with the guidance for Research Funders, Authors and Publishers issued by the Research Information Network (RIN), IJUSEng additionally requires all authors to acknowledge their funding agency in a consistent fashion.

Referencing style

IJUSEng adheres to the Harvard reference style.

Guidelines for submitting supplemental files

The journal is able to host approved supplemental materials online, alongside the full articles. Supplemental files will be subjected to peer-review alongside the article.

English language editing services

Non-English speaking authors who would like to refine their use of language in their manuscripts might consider using a professional editing service. Contact the Editorial Office for further information.

Submission requirements

Use the Submissions Checklist to double-check that all requirements have been complied with.

Copyright, author rights, responsibilities and privacy

The names and email addresses entered anywhere on the IJUSEng website will be used exclusively for the purposes of communication between the author and the journal Editor and will not be made available for any other purpose or to any other party.

Manuscript submission

Manuscripts should be submitted through the IJUSEng website (www.ijuseng.com) or sent by email to the attention of the Editor, Dr Pascual Marques, to editor@ijuseng.com. Any further information in support of online submissions can be entered in Comments to the Editor or uploaded as a supplementary file. We would welcome suggestions for at least three appropriate expert referees. This will assist us in enhancing our Experts Database and one of your suggestions may be asked to review your submission. The experts must not be from your institution.

After Submission

Manuscript Acceptance

IJUSEng places great emphasis on the quality of the articles published. Articles are sent to 2-3 experts for peer review. The reviewers' recommendations determine whether an article will be accepted, accepted subject to minor changes, accepted subject to resubmission with significant changes, or rejected. For articles which require changes, the same reviewers will be used to ensure that the quality of the revised article is acceptable. The Editor in Chief reserves the right to refuse any article, whether invited or otherwise, and to make suggestions and/or modifications before publication. The publisher shall furnish authors of accepted articles with proofs for the correction of printing errors. The proofs shall be returned within 14 calendar days of submittal. The publishers shall not be held responsible for errors which are the result of authors' oversights.

Multiple authors

A *corresponding author* is expected to be responsible for the article during the refereeing process, and for the collection and provision of the copyright assignment from each author after acceptance.

After Acceptance

Proofs

A PDF of the proofs is emailed to the corresponding author.

E-Prints and complimentary copies

Marques Aviation Ltd Press provides authors with access to a PDF of their final article once it has been included within an issue. Articles must be used in the ways described in these guidelines. Authors are offered the option to subscribe to the journal at a special author's price.

Online publication

IJUSEng benefits from online publishing, which significantly reduces the lead time between submission and publication.
